Job Description:

UTeach-Liberal Arts at The University of Texas at Austin invites applications for a Part-Time Clinical Assistant Professor.

Purpose of the Position:

Teach and coordinate the *UTL 360: Problems/Principles of Secondary Education* course and the student teachers seeking secondary social studies certification.

Essential Functions:

Serve as the coordinator of the course *UTL 360: Problems/Principles of Secondary Education* which would involve organizing and planning course topics and materials and collaborating with practicum lecturers, cooperating teachers and field supervisors. Requires twelve hours at UT's main campus that include the three-hour course on Thursday evenings from 5:00 - 8:00 and nine hours in the office. Serve as a liaison between UTeach-Liberal Arts and school campuses, and provide outreach and placement services. Work with UT staff, faculty, and academic advisors to implement program and other program related tasks.

Qualifications

Required Qualifications:

Bachelor's degree. Must hold a social studies or History teacher certification. Twelve years of experience as teacher, administrator, or evaluator in a secondary setting with preference for public school experience. Experience developing academic curriculum. Excellent interpersonal communication skills, and the ability to foster and maintain a positive, team-oriented environment.

Preferred Qualifications:

Master's degree or PhD. More than above stated qualifications. Experience with educational uses of technology. Active participation in professional organization and activities.
